This green marvel reveals how inventive eco-friendly methods and a plethora of building products can intertwine to effectively create a sustainable structure

AMIDST THE POLLUTED landscape of Gurgaon's Udyog Vihar, the Wipro Technology Centre emerges as the most eco-friendly edifice. This is perhaps the strongest contrast it sets, and its location has won it an extra green rating from the US Green Building Council. By bagging 57 out of 69 points it has won the coveted Platinum rating, and has been declared as the most energy efficient building in Asia.

Designed by architect Vidur Bhandari, and shorn of fads and fancies that other hi-tech buildings usually wear, the WTC stands simple but efficient in its dimensions. As you enter the building, an imposing blue glass cone laced with structural glazing greets you. But the rest is simple.

WTC has been awarded the Platinum for addressing the highest number of issues such as using water resources,
